The veranda, especially the one in the rear, should be built with the thought that it is frequently to be used as a playroom for children and as an airing place for babies. It should be so arranged that the child can be left with safety while the mother performs the household, duties. Sometimes the floor of the veranda is laid with a-inch crack between the boards, chiefly for the purpose of shedding water. Such a floor is uncomfortable to walk upon, especially for children with bare feet, and money or trinkets may be dropped through the cracks. A better method is to put in a tight floor with a pitch of one-fourth inch per foot.
