Godey s is remembered today primarily for its fashion plates, but its readers found much more in it: each monthly issue included editorials, non-fiction, short stories, and poetry. This anthology series aims to collect and present some of the poetry found in Godey s and in Hale s earlier publication, the Ladies Magazine. This current volume includes poems on the wind, the rain, and the night published in the two magazines between 1829 and 1874. Have our experiences of these things changed in the past two centuries?
